

The Hybrid Festival invades the city and streets of Mondovì, in the province of Cuneo, from 20 to 22 July and is promoted and organised by the Fondazione Cirko Vertigo.

The Hybrid Festival develops in synergy with the Piazza di Circo Festival, a kermesse organised by the L'Albero del Macramè Association, sharing its urban spaces and programming period. A festival within the festival, to increase dialogue between different organisations and arts, to create a network, to optimise resources and workforce, and to give the public a radically smart cultural offer.

DIALOG CITY is a new way of conceiving and applying digital transformation. The aim is to combine spaces dedicated to social aggregation with urban digitisation, while respecting the environment and eco-sustainable policies.

Hybrid Festival consists of workshops and the new performance format 24 Hours x 24 Minutes, devised by choreographer Raffaele Irace, in which two dancers, Marco Volta and Rosalie Wanka, share a stage space - in different locations in the city of Mondovi - for 24 hours: at the end they present a performance of at least 24 minutes.

The events are streamed live, in La diretta section of the <u>blucinQue Nice app</u> and on the <u>Fondazione Cirko Vertigo website</u>.

During the three days of the festival, the Game Jam is a programme of participatory workshops in which the citizenship is the protagonist, realised in parallel and broadcasted in connection with the City of Aschaffenburg in Germany, the leading partner of the Dialog City project.

Three dance and performing study workshops are scheduled, three "experiences", each lasting about two hours, about the concept of discovery, creation, composition, led by professional dancers and choreographers Daniela Paci, Cecilia Castellari and Davide Degano.

Lastly, the public restitution of the artistic residency of Anne Fehres and Luke Conroy, a multidisciplinary duo selected by the Dialog City Art for public residency programme. For four weeks, Anne and Luke observed the local Mondovi community, contacting it through specific engagement activities: the result, a large-scale photographic composition in which the entire city is protagonist.

DANCE AND PERFORMANCE WORKSHOPS

Three dance and performance workshops, defined by their creator Raffaele Irace as experiences, each lasting approximately two hours. The first experience focuses on the concept of discovery, the second on creation, the third and last on composition. The workshops, open to professional and amateur dancers, performers, acrobats, actors, but also to anyone who wants to get involved by moving their own body, are led by professional dancers and choreographers Daniela Paci, Cecilia Castellari and Davide Degano. At the end of the last experience, the meeting with the players of 24 Hours x 24 Minutes involve the workshop participants in creating.

GAME JAM: OUR COMMON FUTURE

A participatory workshop for citizens, students and activists, held in parallel and broadcast in connection with the City of Aschaffenburg in Germany, the lead partner of the Dialog City project. The aim: to jointly develop game ideas and design concrete prototypes that address key issues on our future: climate change, the current economic crisis and global interdependencies. In the Game Jam perimeter, generating innovative ideas and bringing complex issues to the surface with simplicity and insight.

Several teams on site, in Aschaffenburg and Mondoví, develop game ideas on a specific theme within a specific time frame and are supported by supervisors Stefan Horn and Axel Watzke, and other professional game designers, to convert these ideas into playable prototypes using agile development methods. The playtests developed by the different groups become online presentations between the two cities involved.

For four weeks, Anne and Luke observe the local Mondovi community and establish contact and dialogue with it through specific engagement activities. The result of the artistic residency is a large-scale photographic composition exhibited to the public during the festival.

Everyone can contribute their shots to the News from home project: these photographs, the artists explain, can be of anything - one's neighbours, an object, a meal, a building - with the aim of capturing Mondoví's past, its present and shared hopes for the future.
